Toronto, ON - May 24, 2024 - The Canadian Sindhi Association (CANSA) is deeply saddened and outraged by the tragic murder of Nasarullah Gadhani, a brave and dedicated Sindhi journalist who was gunned down by the local mafia in Mirpur Mathelo, Sindh, Pakistan.

Nasarullah Gadhani was a committed and fearless journalist who worked tirelessly to uncover the truth and shed light on critical public issues. His untimely death is a profound loss to the field of journalism and to the Sindhi community, both in Pakistan and abroad.
